From: Arthur L. Broida FOMC meeting

As you know, the planned date of the March FOMC meeting was recently shifted from Tuesday, March 20, to Thursday, March 22, to avoid a conflict with an expected meeting of the "Committee of 20" on March 20. Because of scheduling problems that have arisen in connection with the C-20 meeting, it now appears quite possible that the FOMC will be able to meet on the original date of March 20, which we assume would be more convenient for the members. Pending final resolution of the C-20 scheduling problem, we suggest that you hold both March 20 and March 22 open for a possible FOMC meeting.
