Ringling

NARRATOR. Have you gotten a phone call supposedly from the Federal Reserve, claiming that there's suspicious activity on your bank account? Or that there's a warrant out for your arrest?

It's a scam!

If you get one of these scam calls, HANG UP. If it's a voicemail message, DO NOT return the call.

The Fed never calls members of the general public unsolicited. There are NO personal Federal Reserve bank accounts and we certainly don't issue "warrants" for arrest.

If you've already answered such a call and think your personal financial information has been compromised, contact your bank and local law enforcement. You can also file a complaint with the FBI's Internet Crime Complaint Center at ic3.gov.
