A proposed schedule for FOMC meetings in 1994 that follows the pattern of recent years is shown below. As usual, the intervals between meetings have been made as equal as possible, taking into account the constraints imposed by IMF/BIS meetings, Humphrey-Hawkins reporting dates, U.S. Treasury quarterly refunding auctions, various holidays, and the release of the employment report. The November 15 date is not ideal in terms of intermeeting intervals, but the better November 8 date would conflict with an anticipated BIS meeting and the Treasury quarterly refunding. The February 1995 meeting is scheduled for the 7th and 8th, but the 2nd and 3rd should be kept open for now.

Please advise me by October 8 whether the proposed schedule is acceptable to you.
